- DHR, a for-profit physicianowned hospital, was founded in 1997 to help over 1.3 million residents resolve limited healthcare access challenges in a community lacking public and county hospitals.
- With over 500 beds, DHR is the largest independent hospital campus in Hidalgo County, TX.
- DHR offers over 70 specialties and sub-specialties with 750 practicing physicians and 1,200 nurses.

- » DHR was the first hospital in South Texas to acquire a PET/CT scanner and the first to introduce da Vinci robotic surgical technology.
- » DHR's Women's Hospital is the only facility in South Texas dedicated exclusively to women's health care and features a level III-C neonatal ICU, which is consistently ranked among the top % of hospitals globally by the Vermont Oxford Network.
- » DHR established biomedical research institute to bring innovative therapies and treatment regimens to the Rio Grande Valley.
- » DHR is the first hospital to form a Bariatric and Metabolic Institute affiliation with the world-renowned Cleveland Clinic, giving DHR direct access to the Clinic's practices and research.
