### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

DHR Health in conjunction with the faculty associated with the University of Houston College of Pharmacy (UHCOP) offers a 12-month PGY1 pharmacy residency program designed to expose residents to a comprehensive clinical environment in which they will develop knowledge and skills in direct patient care in ambulatory and acute care settings. The program has two residency positions available with competitive salary and benefits. The purpose of the program is to build on the Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training. *The DHR Health PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program conducted by DHR Health and faculty from University of Houston College of Pharmacy, Edinburg, TX has an accredited status with ASHP.*


